



## PPMEC COLLEGIATE RESOLUTION 03/2014

Establishes criteria for the constitution of the PPMEC Comission.

According to Art. 5 of the current statute of the PPMEC, the Program Collegiate is responsible for assigning the Graduate Commission. Art. 6 established that this Commission is constituted of more than three permanent supervisors and one student representative elected by the Program Collegiate and allowed a two-year term, including a consecutive renewal, managed by the Program Coordinator.

According to its 1<sup>st</sup> Regular Meeting of February 28, 2014 and the procedural attributions delegated by the Graduate Program of the University of Brasília (Resolution CEPE 91/2004), the Collegiate of the Graduate Program in Mechatronic Systems of the UnB – PPMEC

## DETERMINES

**Art. 1** The Graduate Commission must be constituted of a permanent supervisor from each Research Line in the Program.

**Art. 2** It is optional to the teachers integrating a certain Research Line to indicate one of their pairs to compose the Commission, according to Art. 1.

Art. 3 - This Resolution comes into force on this date.
